We are looking for a skilled and diligent individual to join the team and help oversee, encourage and deliver the projects that have been identified. They will help NPNP projects implement their vision and draw together the East Anglia NPNP community, offering support, networking and helping them access resources. They will form part of the District team discerning God's leading and prayerfully help nurture new faith communities and their leaders in reaching new people with the Gospel.

Salary **£18 per hour** for a part-time position of **18 hours** per week. Permanent position dependent on continuing funding, initially identified for 5 years.
